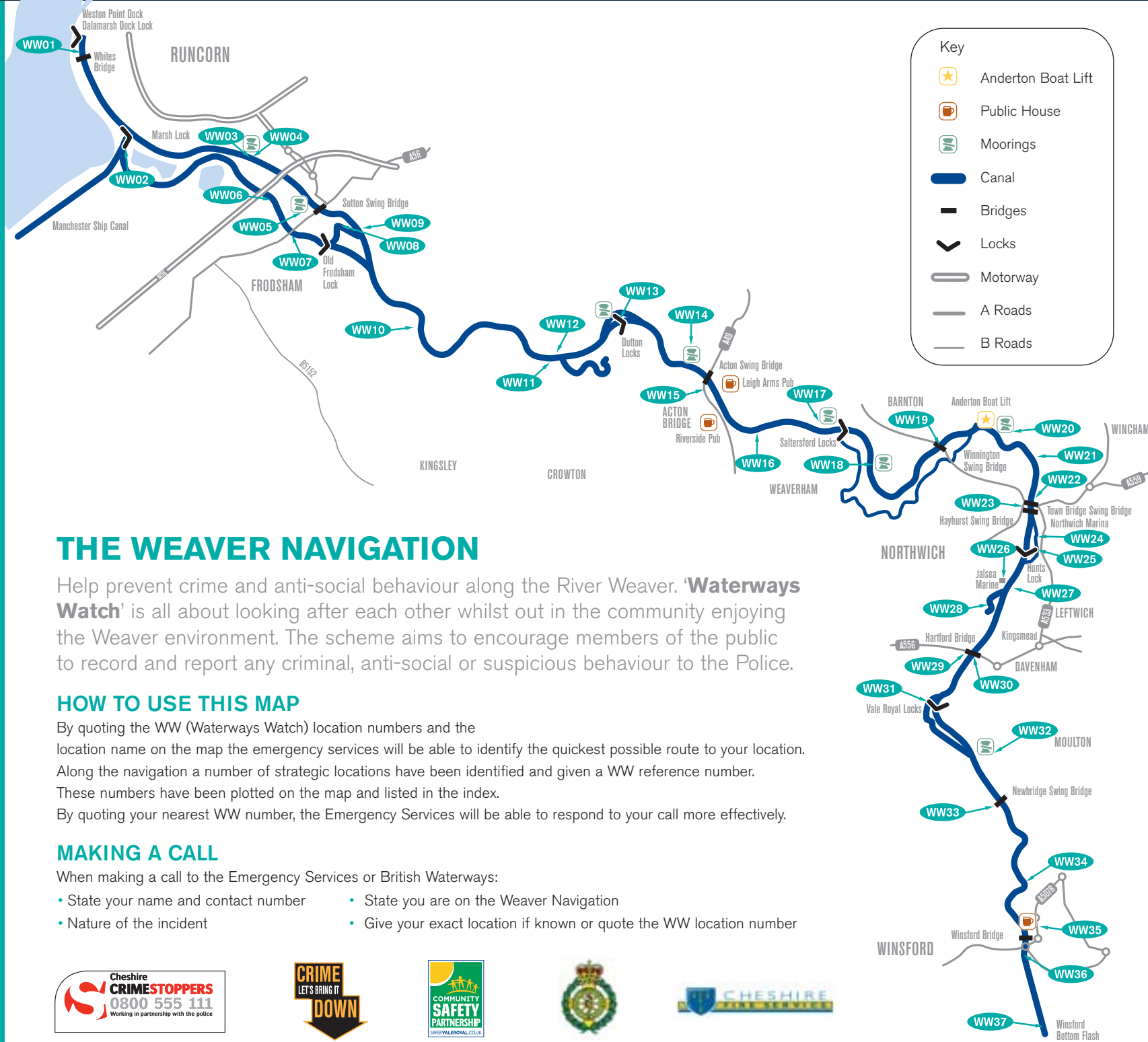

THE WEAVER NAVIGATION

Help prevent crime and anti-social behaviour along the River Weaver. 'Waterways Watch' is all about looking after each other whilst out in the community enjoying the Weaver environment. The scheme aims to encourage members of the public to record and report any criminal, anti-social or suspicious behaviour to the Police.

HOW TO USE THIS MAP

By quoting the WW (Waterways Watch) location numbers and the location name on the map the emergency services will be able to identify the quickest possible route to your location. Along the navigation a number of strategic locations have been identified and given a WW reference number. These numbers have been plotted on the map and listed in the index. By quoting your nearest WW number, the Emergency Services will be able to respond to your call more effectively.

MAKING A CALL

When making a call to the Emergency Services or British Waterways:

- State your name and contact number
- State you are on the Weaver Navigation
- Nature of the incident
- Give your exact location if known or quote the WW location number



Your safety is important

Always put your own safety first and do not take any risks. If the incident requires immediate police action dial 999.

HELP US PROTECT YOUR WATERWAY BY: OBSERVING

Suspicious or unacceptable behaviour, for example

- Stone throwing
- Theft
- Anti-social behaviour
- Threats to people or wildlife
- Motorcycles being ridden on the towpath
- Inconsiderate use of craft
- Drug abuse

RECORDING

Note what you see and list the nature of the incident

- Did you hear names
 - Prominent accents
 - Height of those involved
 - Hair colour
 - Description of clothing e.g. logos
 - Approximate age
 - Distinguishing features e.g. tattoos
 - Vehicles or motor cycles involved registration, colour or make
 - **Consider using a camera to photograph offenders.** (They often leave the scene if they believe they may be identified).
- Please do not put yourself in danger. Only take this course of action if you consider it safe to do so.**

REPORTING

POLICE

For serious incidents dial **999** and ask for the police. (e.g. actual and immediate threats to life or property)

Dial **0845 458 0000** for non-urgent incidents requiring Police action or to pass information. Your call will be assessed and may result in police attendance, or:

- You may be offered crime prevention advice
- The incident may be passed to a police neighbourhood Community Action Team
- The information may be referred to our intelligence unit, who monitor developing problems for targeted police action.
